San Diego at Colorado

- \* This will be baseball's first one-game playoff since 1999, when the New York Mets beat Cincinnati 5-0 to advance to the NLDS, and the seventh one-game playoff in major league history.
- \* Today's game will be played in Denver because the Rockies won one of a series of coin flips recently conducted to determine possible tiebreaker sites.
- \* The winner of this game will face the Phillies in Game 1 of the NLDS on Wednesday at Citizens Bank Park.
- \* The Rockies won the season series between these teams 10-8, including a 5-4 mark against the Padres at Coors Field.
- \* Jake Peavy has no decisions and a 1.29 ERA in two starts against the Rockies this season and is 3-3 with a 3.96 ERA in six career starts at Coors Field. Peavy is 10-1 with a 2.20 ERA in his last 13 starts overall.
- \* Josh Fogg is 5-4 with a 5.83 ERA in 12 home starts this season. Fogg is 1-1 with a 6.28 ERA in three starts against San Diego this season and 3-2 with a 5.48 ERA in nine lifetime starts against the Padres.
- \* The Rockies have won 13 of their last 14 games and were a major league-best 20-8 in September. The Padres have dropped six of their last 10, including two in a row.
- \* Todd Helton is hitting .386 (22-for-57) with four doubles, three homers and 13 RBI over his last 14 games. Helton is 12-for-35 (.343) with two homers in his career against Jake Peavy.
- \* Khalil Greene is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with two doubles, three homers and nine RBI in his last six games.
